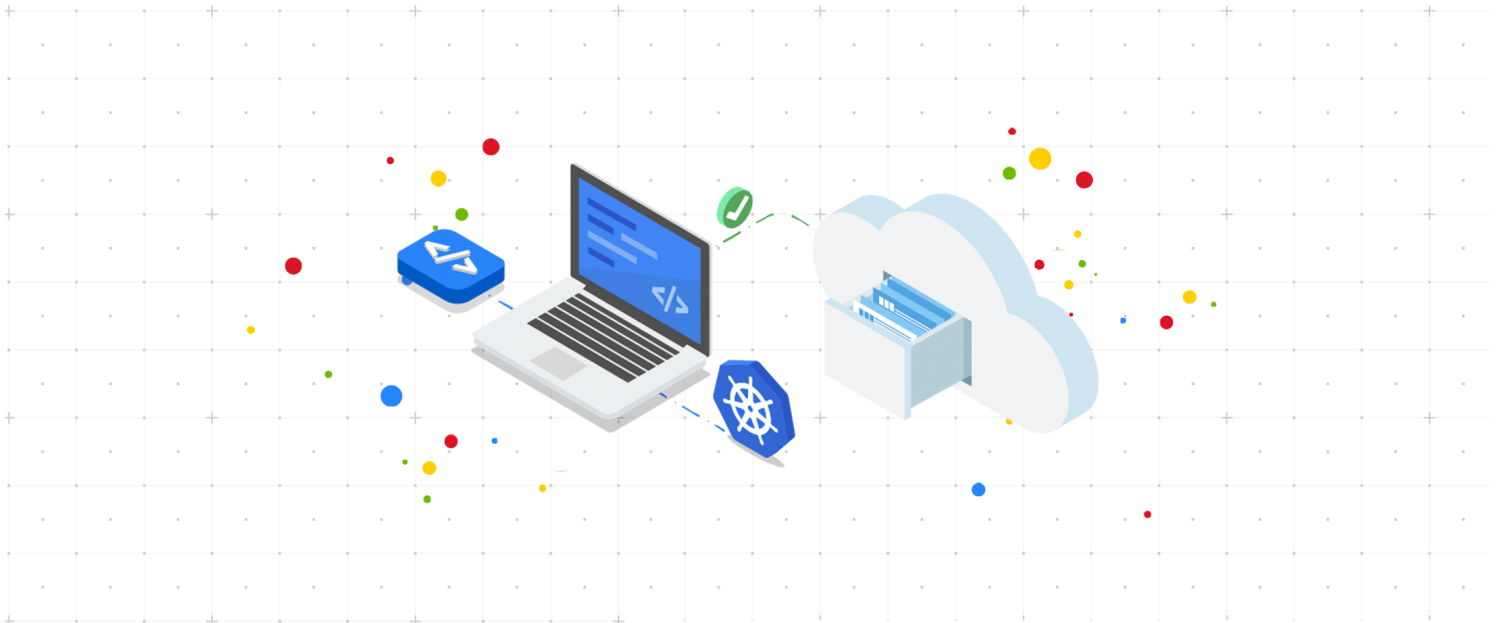

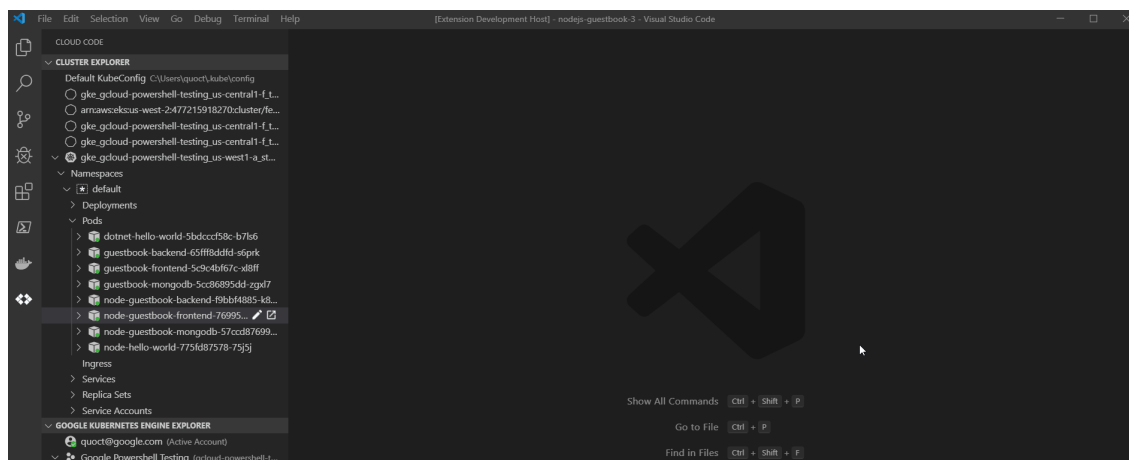

## View Stackdriver logs in VS Code

With the new Cloud Code logs viewer you can access your Stackdriver logs in VS Code directly. Simply open the logs viewer and Cloud Code displays all your Stackdriver logs. You can edit the filters just like you do in Stackdriver, and if you would like to see more detailed information you can easily return to Stackdriver Logging from the IDE with your filters in place.

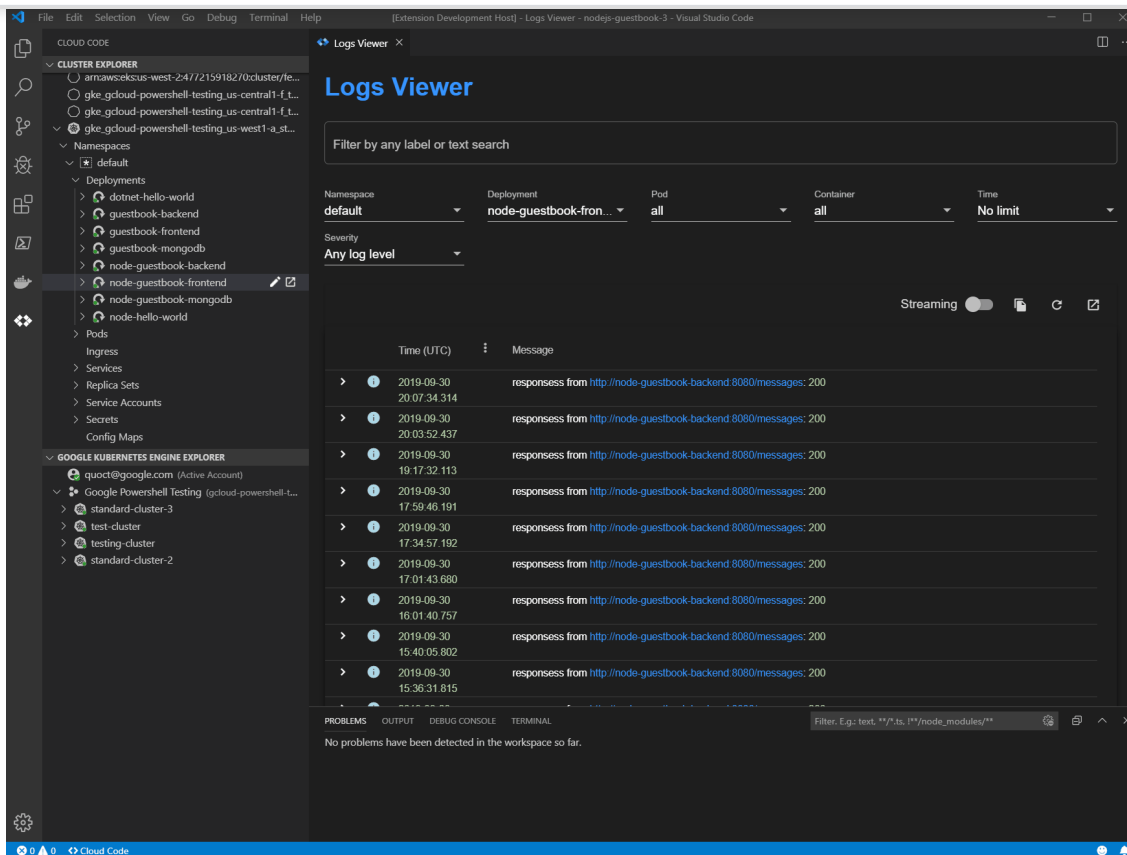

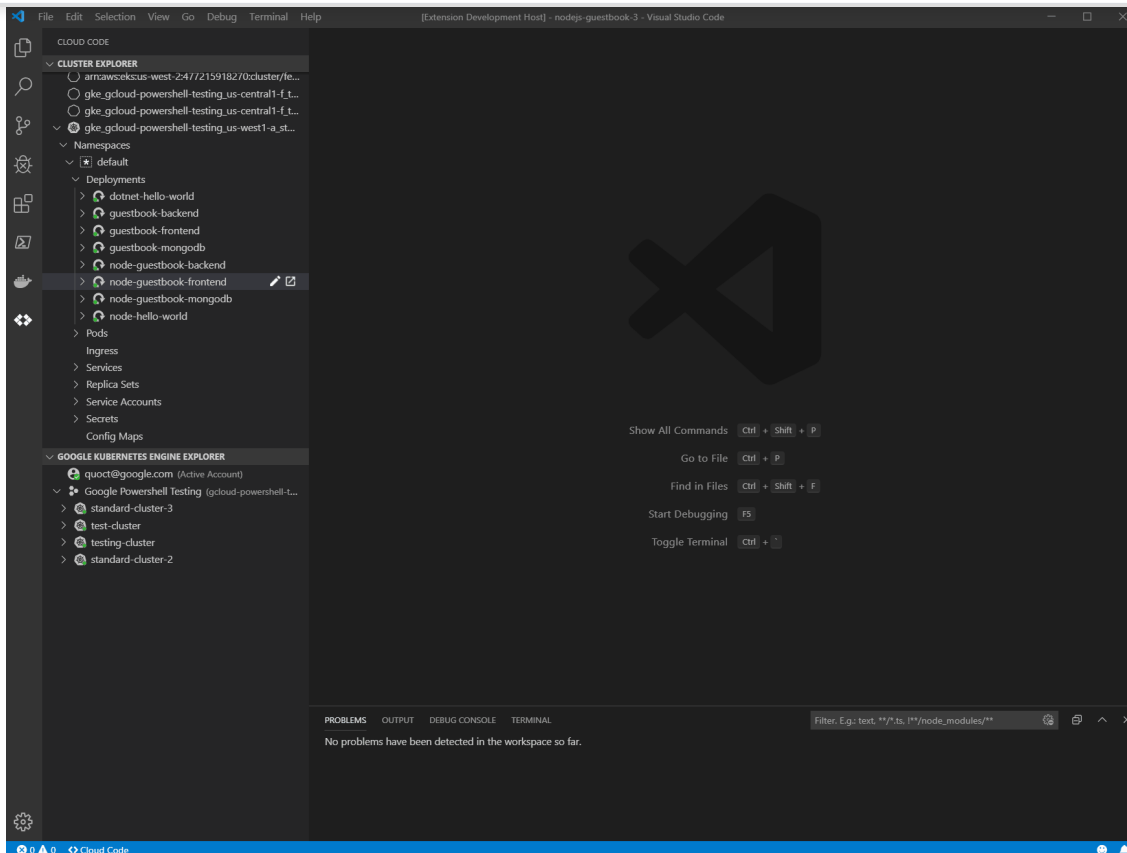
