Viewing Cloud Storage buckets and their contents

To open a bucket and view its contents:

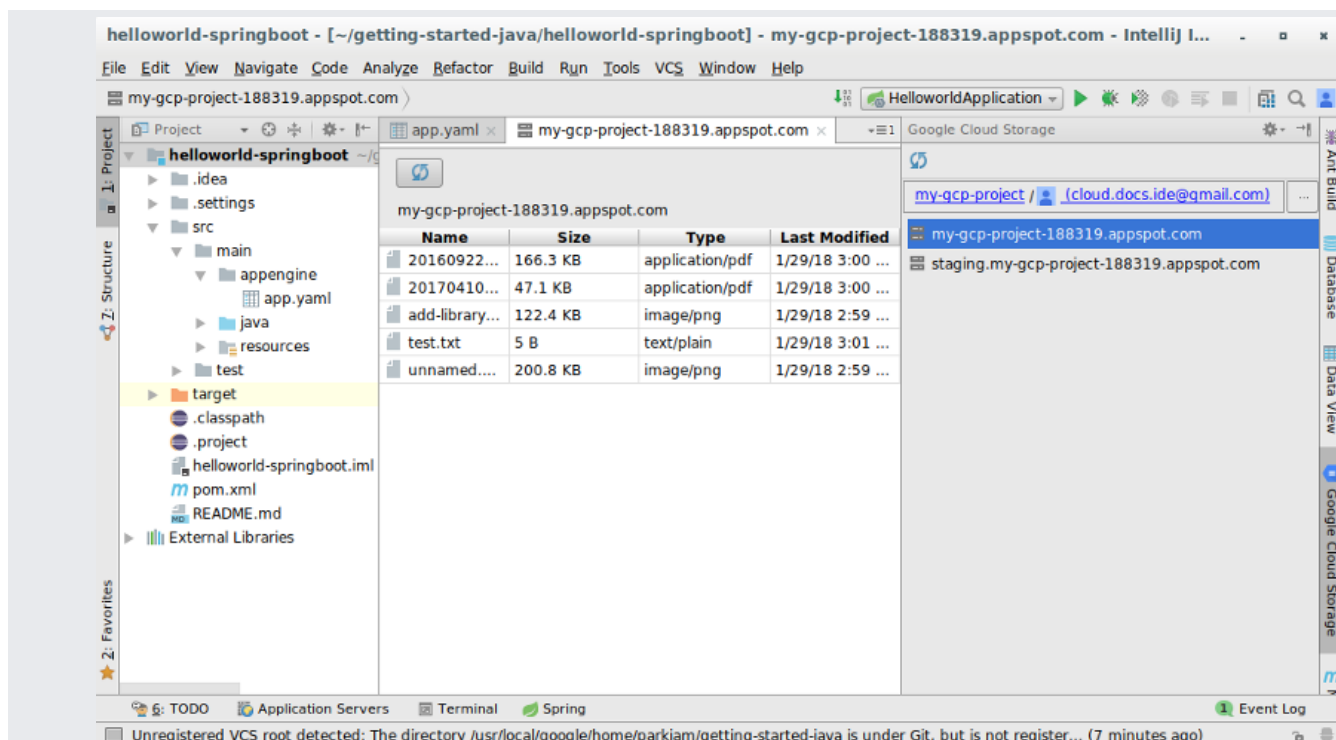
1. Select **Tools > Cloud Code > Browse Cloud Storage buckets**.

The **Cloud Storage** side panel explorer displays.

2. Select your project from the drop-down menu.

The buckets associated with your project display.

3. Double click a bucket to see its contents.



4. If your bucket contains folders, double click the folders to display their contents.
5. Right click a bucket or a file within a bucket to copy its name to your clipboard.
