Learn how to install the Cloud Tools for Eclipse plugin.

Before you begin

1. Install Eclipse IDE for Java EE Developers, version 4.8 or later:

[Download Eclipse](http://www.eclipse.org/downloads/eclipse-packages/) (http://www.eclipse.org/downloads/eclipse-packages/)

2. If you have the Google Plugin for Eclipse installed, complete the [migrating from GPE](/eclipse/docs/migrating-gpe) (/eclipse/docs/migrating-gpe) procedures.

Installing Cloud Tools for Eclipse

To install the plugin:

1. Drag the install button into your running Eclipse workspace:

Or from inside Eclipse, select **Help > Eclipse Marketplace...** and search for **Google Cloud Tools for Eclipse**.

2. Restart Eclipse when prompted.
