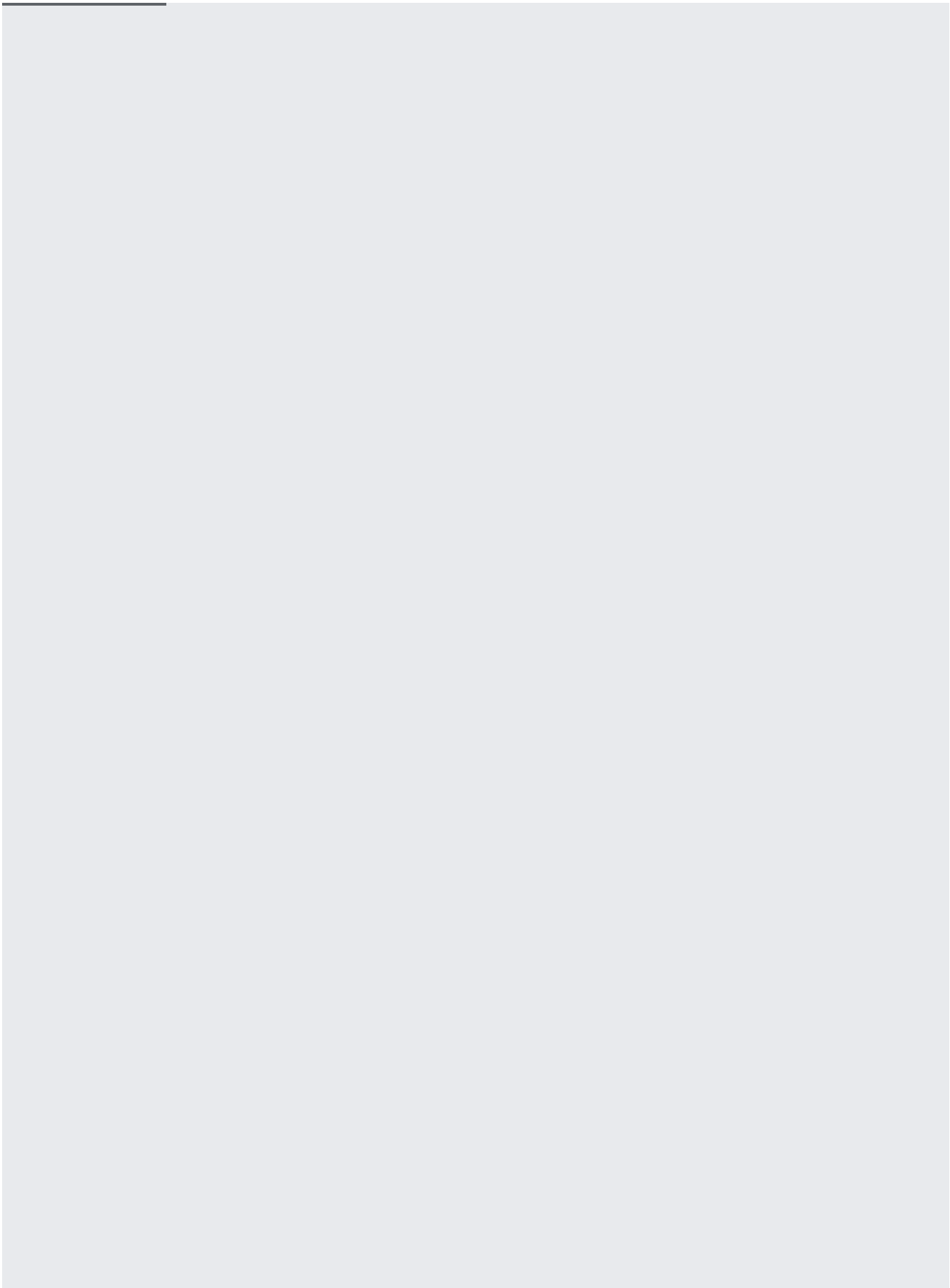












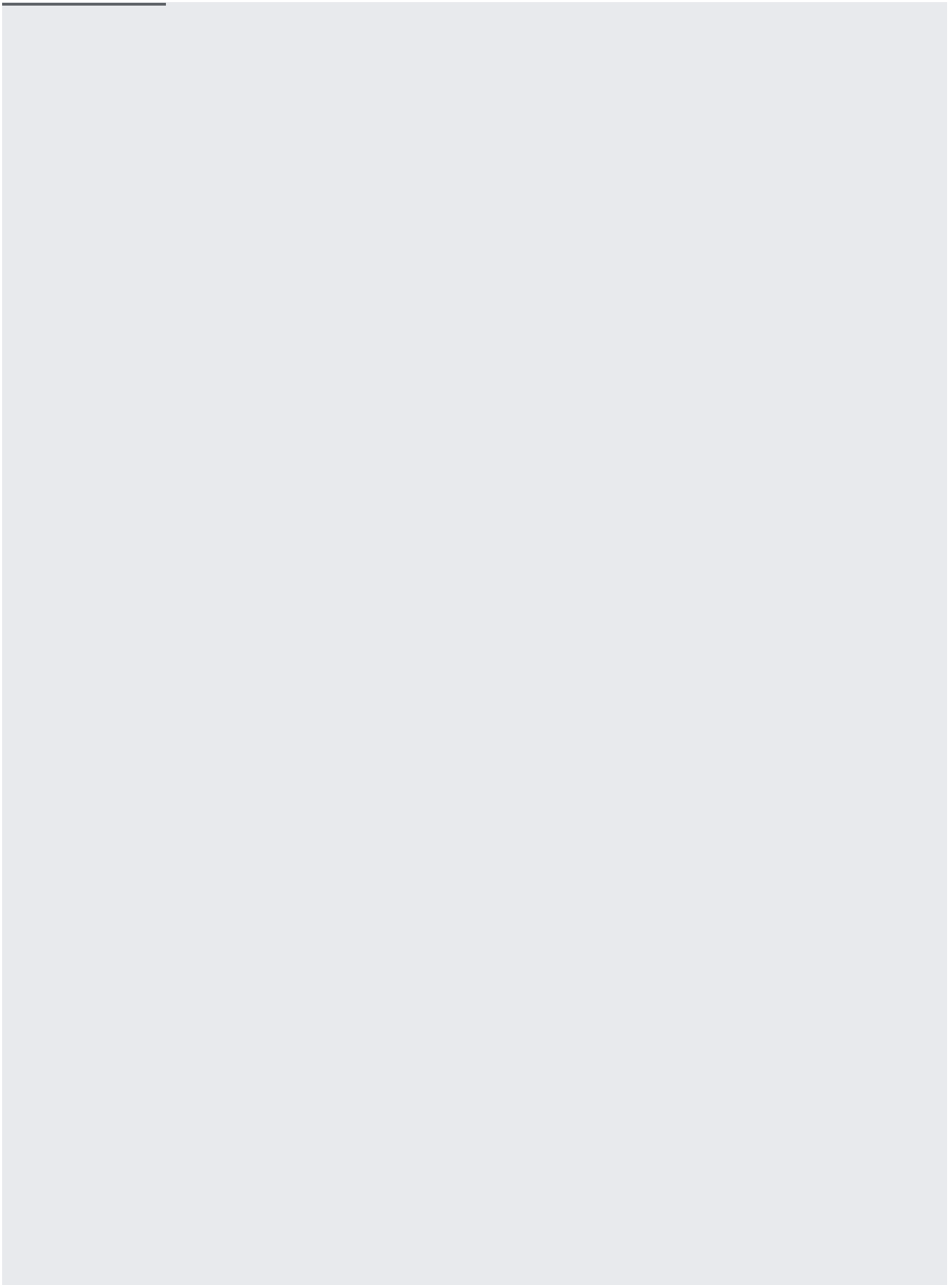
The following samples show how to make the following changes to an HL7v2 store:

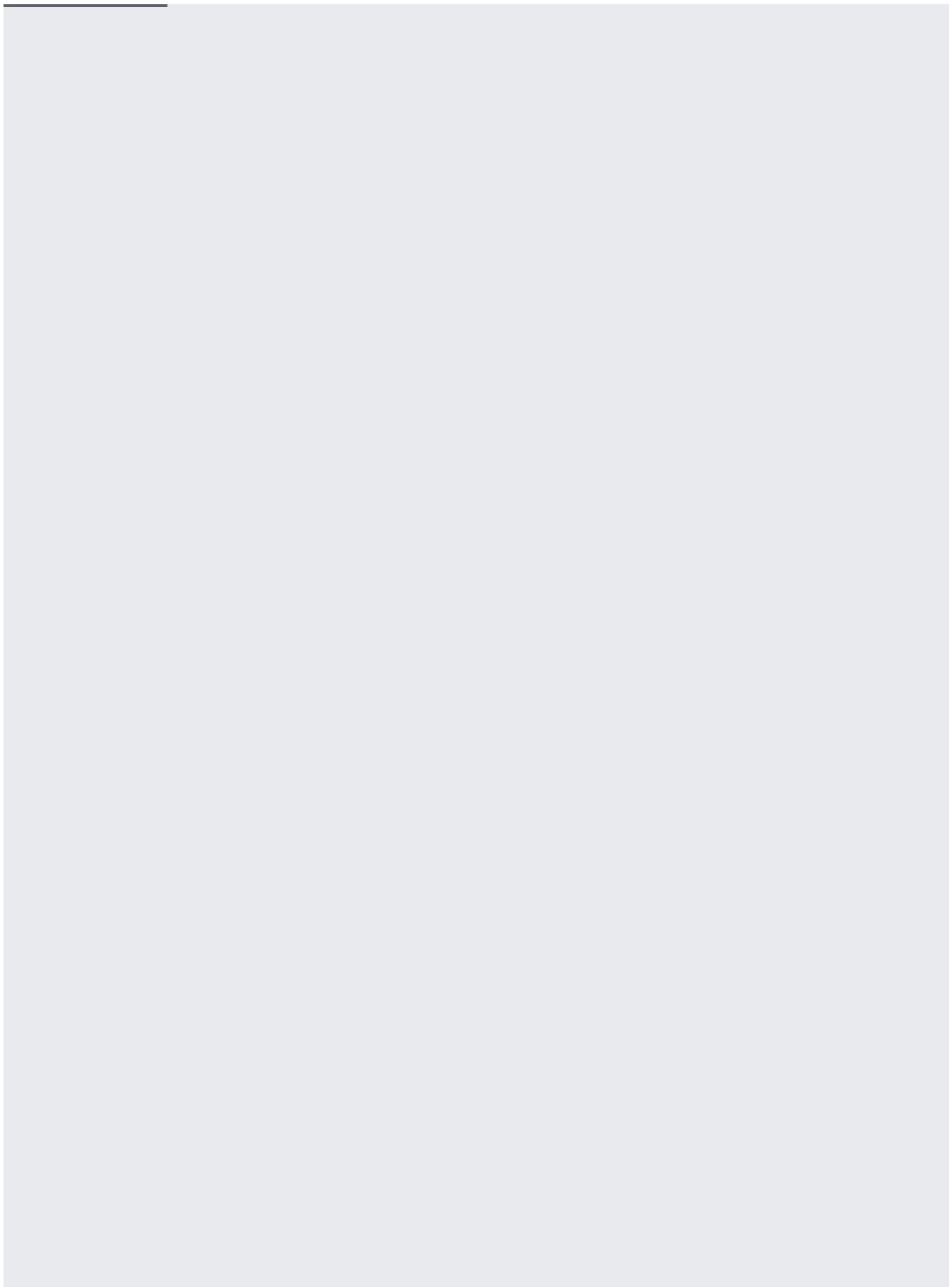
- Edit the Pub/Sub (/pubsub) topic to which the Cloud Healthcare API sends notifications of HL7v2 store changes.
- Edit the labels. Labels (/healthcare/docs/how-tos/labeling-resources) are key-value pairs that help you organize your Google Cloud resources.

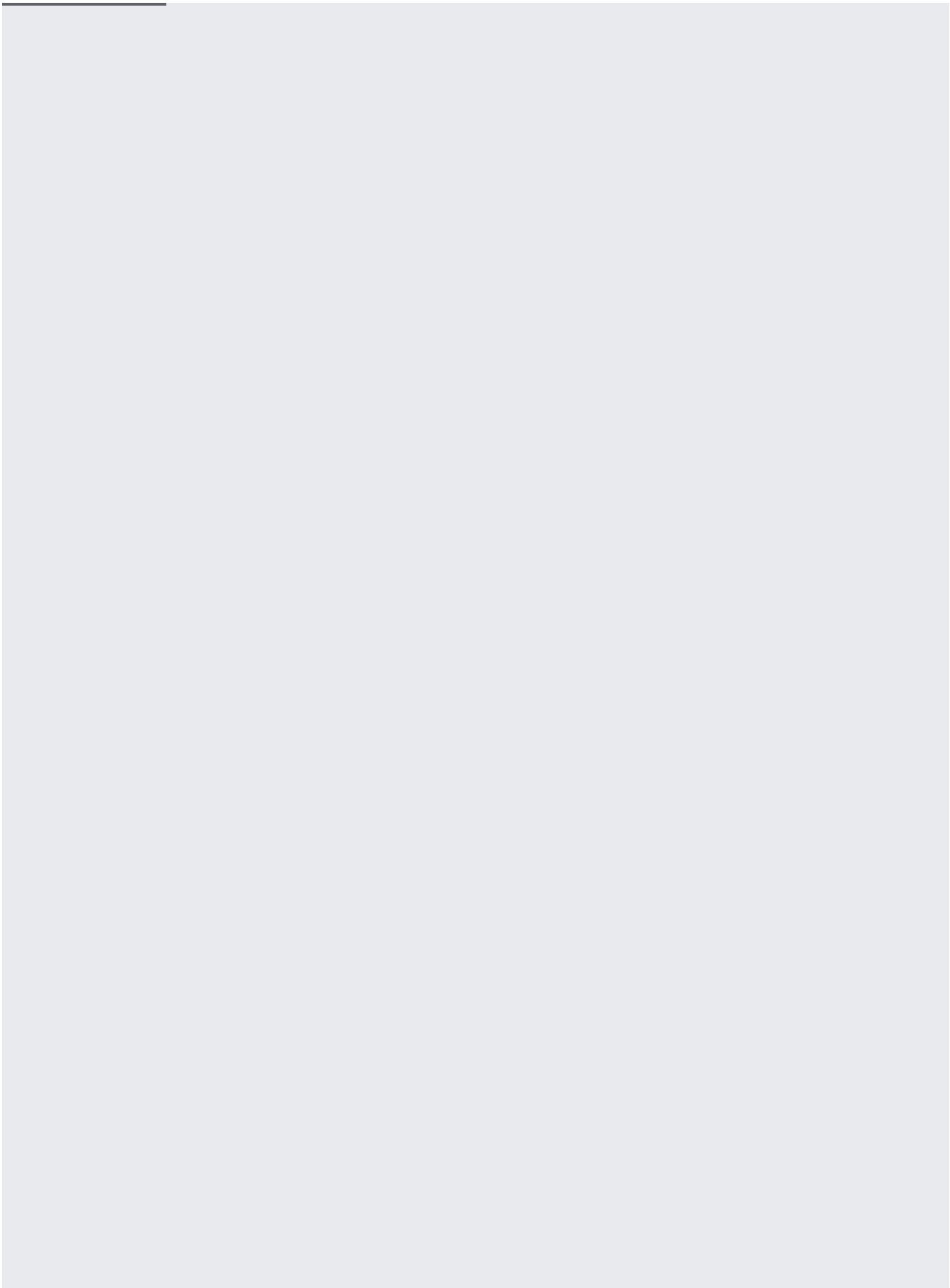
When specifying a Pub/Sub topic, enter the qualified URI to the topic, as shown in the following sample:

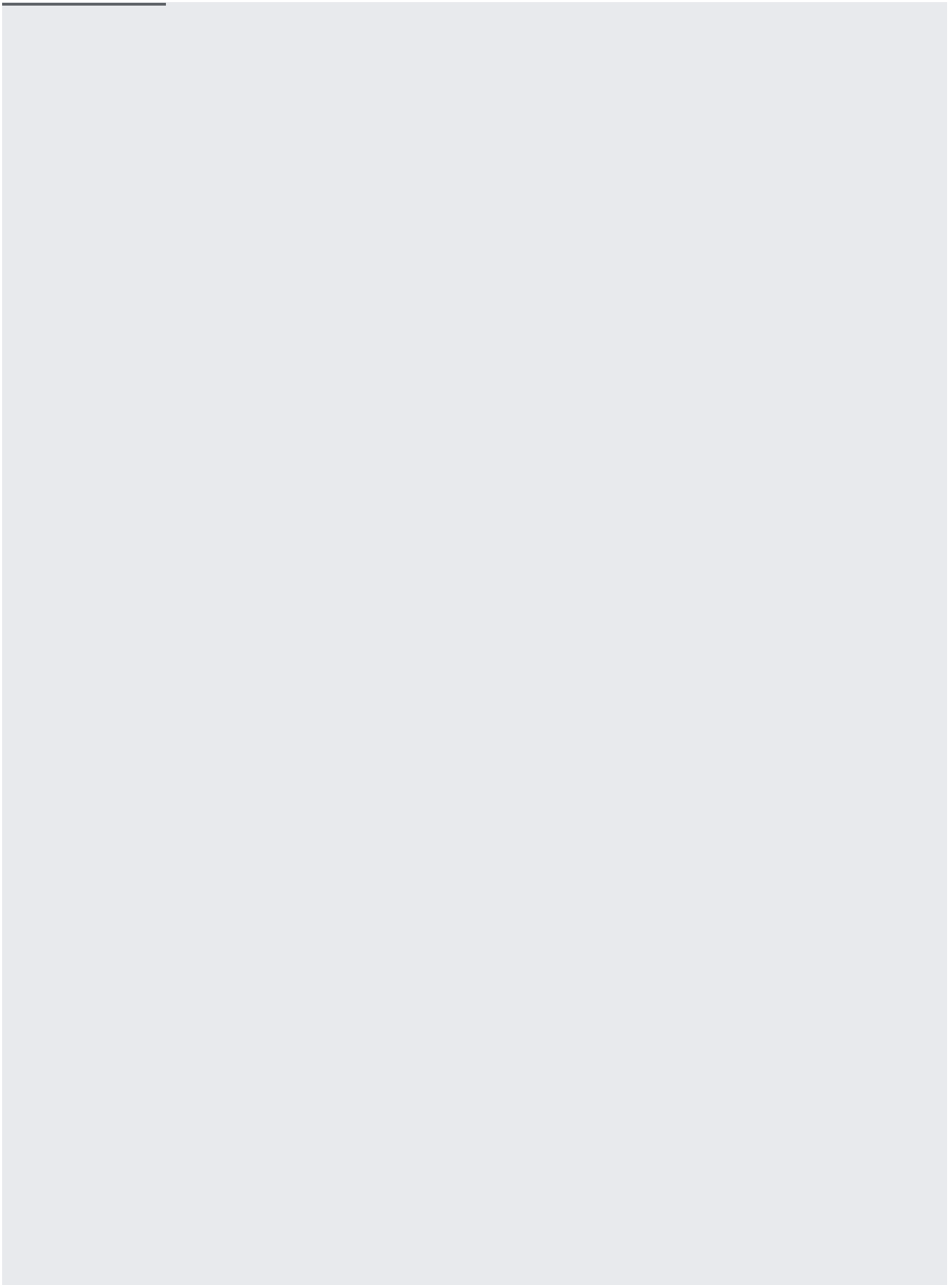
