- To check the status of a BGP session, open the [router list](#) (<https://console.cloud.google.com/hybrid/routers/list>) and view the **BGP sessions** column.

A green circle with a checkmark indicates the session is established.

An red circle with an exclamation mark indicates that the session is still coming up or has already failed. Hover over the exclamation mark for more information. If the session is still coming up, wait a few moments, and then reload the page to verify that the session has been established. If the session failed, view the [logs](#) (<https://cloud.google.com/router/docs/how-to/viewing-logs>) to see information about the session.
- To see the dynamic routes your router has learned in the network, open the [routes list](#) (<https://console.cloud.google.com/networking/routes/list>), and then select **Dynamic**.
