When you enable data logging, you permit Google to collect data from your audio transcription requests. Google then uses this data to improve its machine learning models used for recognizing speech audio.



## Enrolling in data logging


To enroll your Google Cloud Platform project in data logging, follow these steps:

- 1. Go to your project settings for the Speech-to-Text in the <u>Google Cloud Platform</u> <u>Dashboard</u> (https://console.cloud.google.com/apis/api/speech.googleapis.com/).
- 2. In the navigation, click APIs & Services > Dashboard.
- 3. From the list of APIs enabled for the project, select **Cloud Speech API**.

### 4. Select the **Data logging** tab.



#### 5. Click Enable data logging.




# Disabling data logging

- 1. Go to your project settings for the Speech-to-Text in the <u>Google Cloud Platform</u> <u>Dashboard</u> (https://console.cloud.google.com/apis/api/speech.googleapis.com/).
- 2. In the navigation, click APIs & Services > Dashboard.

- 3. From the list of APIs enabled for the project, select Cloud Speech API.
- 4. Select the **Data logging** tab.
- 5. Click **Disable data logging**.
