Lists users in the specified Cloud SQL instance.

Path parameters

Parameters	
project	string Project ID of the project that contains the instance.
instance	string Database instance ID. This does not include the project ID.

Request body

The request body must be empty.

Response body

If successful, the response body contains data with the following structure:

Fields

kind	string This is always sql#usersList .
items[]	object (<u>User</u> (https://cloud.google.com/sql/docs/mysql/admin-api/rest/v1beta4/users#User)) backupRuns.list of user resources in the instance.
nextPageToken	string An identifier that uniquely identifies the operation. You can use this identifier to retrieve the Operations resource that has information about the operation.
