Fields

corrected	boolean Indicates if the query was corrected by the spell checker.
correctedText	string Correction output consisting of the corrected keyword string.
correctedHtml	string Corrected output with html tags to highlight the corrected words. Corrected words are called out with the "... " html tags. For example, the user input query is "software engineer", where the second word, "enginear," is incorrect. It should be "engineer". When spelling correction is enabled, this value is "software <i>engineer</i> ".
