Resource: Company

A Company resource represents a company in the service. A company is the entity that owns job postings, that is, the hiring entity responsible for employing applicants for the job position.

name	<p>string</p> <p>Required during company update.</p> <p>The resource name for a company. This is generated by the service when a company is created.</p> <p>The format is "projects/{project_id}/tenants/{tenantId}/companies/{company_id}", for example, "projects/foo/tenants/bar/companies/baz".</p> <p>If tenant id is unspecified, the default tenant is used. For example, "projects/foo/companies/bar".</p>
displayName	<p>string</p> <p>Required. The display name of the company, for example, "Google LLC".</p>
externalId	<p>string</p> <p>Required. Client side company identifier, used to uniquely identify the company.</p> <p>The maximum number of allowed characters is 255.</p>
size	<p>enum (CompanySize (https://cloud.google.com/talent-solution/job-search/docs/reference/rest/v4beta1/projects.companies#Company.CompanySize))</p> <p>The employer's company size.</p>
headquartersAddress	<p>string</p> <p>The street address of the company's main headquarters, which may be different from the job location. The service attempts to geolocate the provided address, and populates a more specific location wherever possible in DerivedInfo.headquarters_location (https://cloud.google.com/talent-solution/job-search/docs/reference/rest/v4beta1/projects.companies#Company.DerivedInfo.FIELDS.headquarters_location)</p>

hiringAgency	<p>boolean</p> <p>Set to true if it is the hiring agency that post jobs for other employers.</p> <p>Defaults to false if not provided.</p>
eeoText	<p>string</p> <p>Equal Employment Opportunity legal disclaimer text to be associated with all jobs, and typically to be displayed in all roles.</p> <p>The maximum number of allowed characters is 500.</p>
websiteUri	<p>string</p> <p>The URI representing the company's primary web site or home page, for example, "https://www.google.com".</p> <p>The maximum number of allowed characters is 255.</p>
careerSiteUri	<p>string</p> <p>The URI to employer's career site or careers page on the employer's web site, for example, "https://careers.google.com".</p>
imageUri	<p>string</p> <p>A URI that hosts the employer's company logo.</p>
keywordSearchableJobCustomAttributes[]	<p>string</p> <p>A list of keys of filterable <u>Job.custom.attributes</u> (https://cloud.google.com/talent-solution/job-search/docs/reference/rest/v4beta1/projects.jobs#Job.FIELDS.custom_attributes), whose corresponding stringValues are used in keyword searches. Jobs with stringValues under these specified field keys are returned if any of the values match the search keyword. Custom field values with parenthesis, brackets and special symbols are not searchable as-is, and those keyword queries must be surrounded by quotes.</p>

derivedInfo	object (<u>DerivedInfo</u> (https://cloud.google.com/talent-solution/job-search/docs/reference/rest/v4beta1/projects.companies#Company.DerivedInfo)) Output only. Derived details about the company.
suspended	boolean Output only. Indicates whether a company is flagged to be suspended from public availability by the service when job content appears suspicious, abusive, or spammy.

CompanySize

An enum that represents the size of the company.

Enums	
COMPANY_SIZE_UNSPECIFIED	Default value if the size isn't specified.
MINI	The company has less than 50 employees.
SMALL	The company has between 50 and 99 employees.
SMEDIUM	The company has between 100 and 499 employees.
MEDIUM	The company has between 500 and 999 employees.
BIG	The company has between 1,000 and 4,999 employees.
BIGGER	The company has between 5,000 and 9,999 employees.
GIANT	The company has 10,000 or more employees.
