# Method: projects.companies.list



Lists all companies associated with the project.

## HTTP request

```
GET https://jobs.googleapis.com/v4beta1/{parent=projects/*/companies
```

The URL uses [gRPC Transcoding](#)

## Path parameters

### Parameters

**parent**

**string**

Required. Resource name of the tenant under which the company is created.

The format is "projects/{project\_id}/tenants/{tenantId}", for example, "projects/foo/tenant/bar".

If tenant id is unspecified, the default tenant will be used, for example, "projects/foo".

## Query parameters

Parameters	
<b>pageToken</b>	<b>string</b> The starting indicator from which to return results.
<b>pageSize</b>	<b>number</b> The maximum number of companies to be returned, at most 100. Default is 100 if a non-positive number is provided.
<b>requireOpenJobs</b>	<b>boolean</b> Set to true if the companies requested must have open jobs.  Defaults to false.  If true, at most <b>pageSize</b> ( <a href="https://cloud.google.com/talent-solution/job-search/docs/reference/rest/v4beta1/projects.tenants.companies/list#body.QUERY_PARAMETERS.page_size">https://cloud.google.com/talent-solution/job-search/docs/reference/rest/v4beta1/projects.tenants.companies/list#body.QUERY_PARAMETERS.page_size</a> ) of companies are fetched, among which only those with open jobs are returned.

## Request body

The request body must be empty.

## Response body

If successful, the response body contains an instance of **ListCompaniesResponse** (<https://cloud.google.com/talent-solution/job-search/docs/reference/rest/v4beta1/ListCompaniesResponse>)

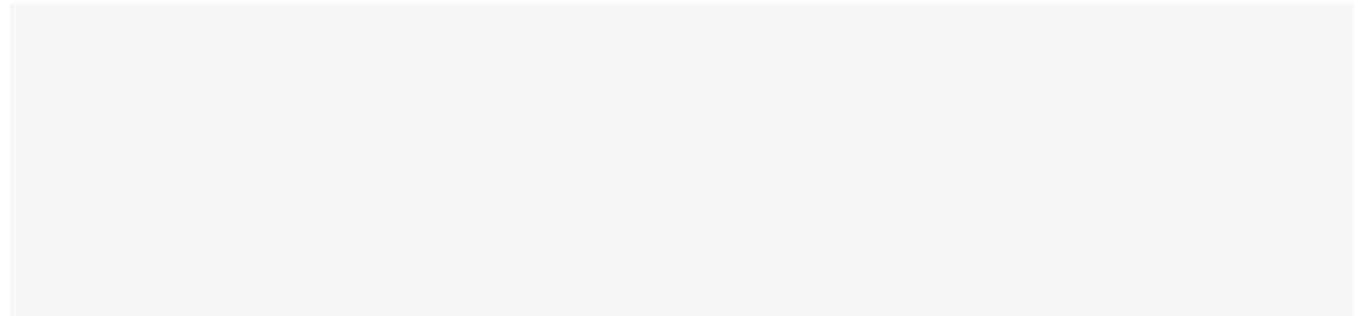
