You can cancel a data capture job that is in progress. When a job is canceled, any files already captured by the job remain on Transfer Appliance. You can restart a canceled job, which resumes from the last job checkpoint. Cancelled jobs display a **Stopped** status in the **Jobs Monitor** window.

To cancel a running data capture job:

- 1. Open the Transfer Appliance Web User Interface.
- 2. In the **Jobs Monitor** pane, identify the job you want to cancel.
- 3. Click the **More** icon next to the job and click **Abort**.
- 4. When the confirmation dialog appears, click **OK**.

If your data size exceeds the capacity of a single Transfer Appliance, <u>capture your data using multiple appliances in succession</u> (/transfer-appliance/docs/2.0/performing-serial-captures).
