Once you complete data rehydration and verify that the data in the Cloud Storage destination bucket is correct, <u>delete the Compute Engine VM</u>

(https://cloud.google.com/compute/docs/instances/stopping-or-deleting-an-instance) hosting the Rehydrator instance to prevent unnecessary costs.
