## HTTP request

GET <https://automl.googleapis.com/v1beta1/{name}/locations>

## Path parameters

### Parameters

<b>name</b>	<b>string</b>
	The resource that owns the locations collection, if applicable.

## Query parameters

<b>filter</b>	<b>string</b>
	The standard list filter.
<b>pageSize</b>	<b>number</b>
	The standard list page size.
<b>pageToken</b>	<b>string</b>
	The standard list page token.
