Method: projects.locations.productSets.list

Lists ProductSets in an unspecified order.

Possible errors:

- Returns `INVALID_ARGUMENT` if `pageSize` is greater than 100, or less than 1.

HTTP request

```
GET https://vision.googleapis.com/v1/{parent=projects/*/locations/*/}productSets
```

Path parameters

Parameters	
parent	string Required. The project from which ProductSets should be listed. Format is <code>projects/PROJECT_ID/locations/LOC_ID</code> .

Query parameters

Parameters	
pageSize	number The maximum number of items to return. Default 10, maximum 100.
pageToken	string The <code>nextPageToken</code> returned from a previous List request, if any.

Request body

The request body must be empty.

<code>nextPageToken</code>	string Token to retrieve the next page of results, or empty if there are no more results in the list.
