# Method: projects.locations.productSets.patch

Makes changes to a ProductSet resource. Only displayName can be updated currently.

#### Possible errors:

- Returns NOT\_FOUND if the ProductSet does not exist.
- Returns INVALID\_ARGUMENT if displayName is present in updateMask but missing from the request or longer than 4096 characters.
